



## How to add Cindicator Tokens to your Wallet?

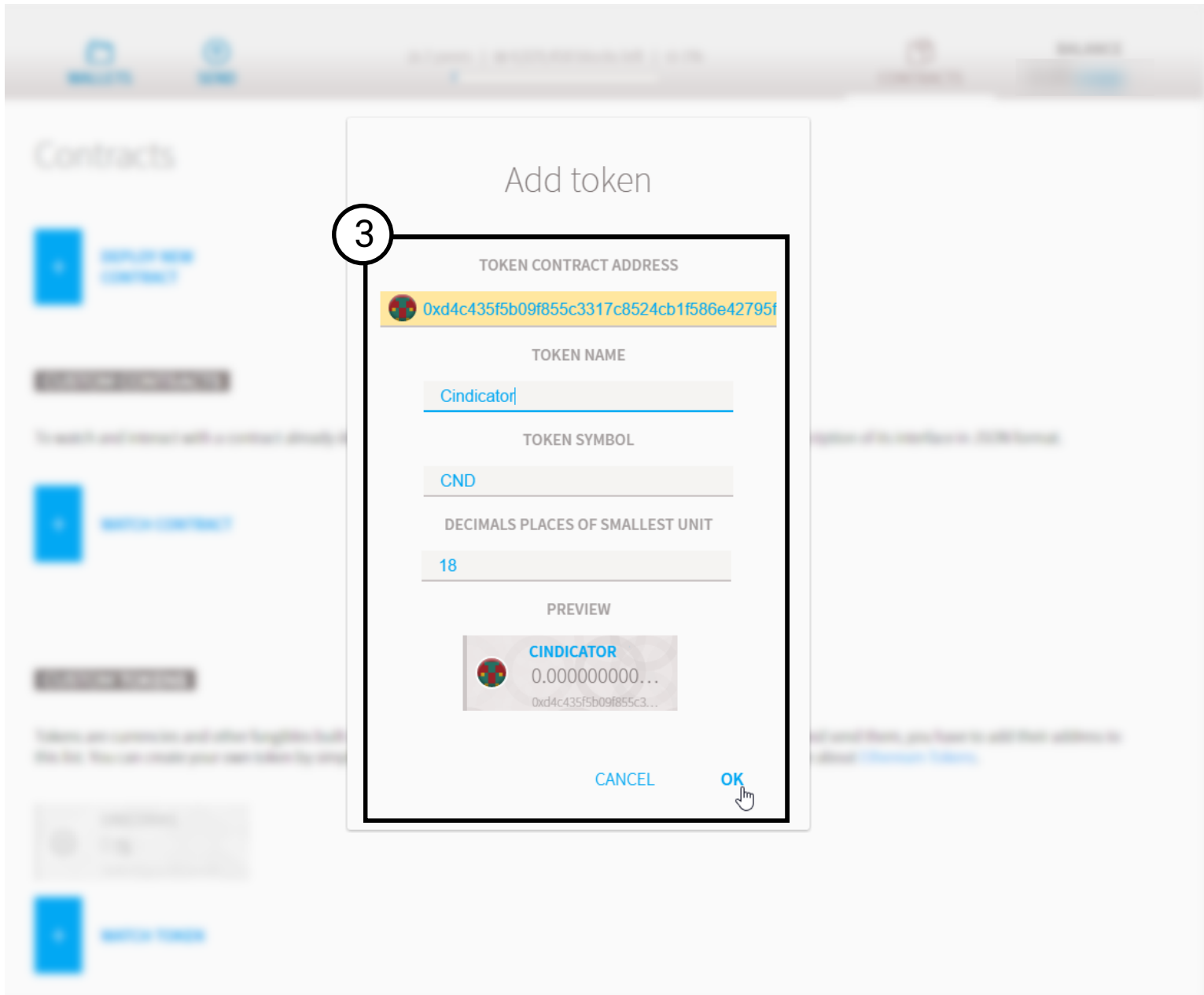
**1** Open "Contracts" tab.

2 Click the "Watch Token" button.
